

CITING *UP TO DATE* ARTICLES IN APA FORMAT (January 2016)

We asked the Style Experts at APA this question. This is the format they want us to use to cite Up to Date articles. Be sure to use the year of the most recent update of the article as the publication date (this is given underneath the title and author listing at top of article.) Use the name of the deputy editor(s) for the article as the editor(s) of the reference work. Section editors do not need to be listed in the reference. Below is a sample citation:
